ADDITIONAL INFO

- We hold Open Auditions and everyone is welcome to come along
- We're opening up our Dwarfs Auditions to anyone, not just small people! For example you could be on your knees (think Lord Farquard from Shrek) – but please bring your own knee pads!
- The aim of the Dwarfs Workshop/Read Through & Principals Read Through is for you to get an idea of the characters and familiarise yourself with the script - so you can give your it your best at the Auditions
- You don't have to attend a Read Through to Audition – but they are there to help if you can make it
- We've divided the dance auditions into Chorus (the Adults) and Younger Dancers (up to about age 14) and Older Dancers (14+). The Younger & Older groups are just for audition purposes as the dance groups for the show are as yet undecided. We may ask some people who come along to the Younger Dancers Audition to come back for the Older Dancer auditions later in the day
